Your Seabeck Community Center (SCC) and the Central Kitsap School District (CKSD) have an Operating Agreement that provides for the operations and use of the Multipurpose building and sports fields on the Seabeck School Campus. This agreement was signed by the president of the school board, the superintendent of the school district and myself for SCC. This agreement details the use of facilities, maintenance, configuration controls, regulations and responsibilities of both parties. CKSD and SCC negotiated this agreement over the past several months. It's a good agreement for both parties and I can email it to anyone who would like to read it. It should be read by everyone in SCC leadership positions.

There has been progress and setbacks on building work projects. The cleaned walls are completely painted and look great. Old tile has been replaced. Heating system work is almost complete. Septic work is progressing. Septic electrical is the critical path to completion and should be completed in March.

Our goal is to do a walk through with CKSD before the end of March to define any additional work that may be required before we can open the Center. Our goal is to have a turnover to SCC in April. Then the volunteers go to work!

CKSD employees and CKSD contactors are doing a good job. They understand and appreciate that this facility will be used to benefit the Seabeck Community. The building won't be perfect, but it surly will look good and function well.

Randy Hanson, an alumni of Seabeck Elementary, has volunteered to make a 4ft by 8ft sign for our building. Please thank Randy and the Hanson Sign Company.

Our goal is to hold a community meeting in the multi-purpose building on Saturday April 10th at 2 pm. Please save the date. We will confirm this date as soon as we can.

We are pleased that "Girls on the Run" will be the 1<sup>st</sup> group to use our Community Center. Their activities will be mostly outside on weekday afternoons starting in April. .
