### Ornamental Aficionados Sculpt Monthly

Evergreen Bonsai Club members inspire each other in the precise — yet peaceful — centuries-old art of the bonsai.

For many Americans their introduction to this deeply symbolic craft occurred during the 1980s while watching the now cult classic *The Karate Kid* (1984), starring Pat Morita as the wise sensai Mr. Miyagi.

“Inside you have strong root. [You] need nothing except what inside you to grow,” Mr. Miyagi counseled teenaged “Daniel San” (Ralph Macchio), using bonsai metaphors. And audiences wept as Mr. Miyagi’s masterpieces were vandalized. Fast forward to 2022 as Evergreen Bonsai Club members move beyond Hollywood and into the ageless world of botanical wonders. The group meets every third Friday at 7 p.m. and welcomes those interested in joining their club.
