Brick Fundraiser Goes Live August 8

The Seabeck Community Center envisions a beautiful, landscaped, family-friendly park setting adjacent to and south of the pickleball courts where all will be welcome to gather together, commune with nature, relax and socialize. This park will initially accommodate picnic tables and benches, but longer term —

pending Central Kitsap School District approval — it will incorporate a children's fitness-oriented playground, along with a timber frame pavilion to be used for shelter, concerts and other activities and events of interest to the community.

The engraved brick fundraiser will be a primary source of funds required to realize this vision. The bricks will be installed in the walkway dividing the pickleball courts from the park, with potential for expansion elsewhere. As of press time the Port of Bremerton was also considering making a donation towards this project which will benefit residents.
