Memorialize Your Loved Ones in Stone

Park and Brick Fundraiser Update

The SCC launched an engraved brick fundraiser to establish a multi-purpose community park to the south of the pickleball court. Fifty-eight individuals (33 SCC members and 21 Seabeck Pickleball Facebook Group members) have purchased a total of 93 bricks to net proceeds of \$14,295.

The Port of Bremerton, the Kitsap County Commission and the Suquamish Tribe have also generously directed grant monies towards our project.

To date, we have used these funds to establish a picnic area under the shade of oak trees with six bright, durable weatherproof tables, two benches and a waste receptacle.

Addressing drainage, safety and engineering components for the 8,000 square foot park area is next, with our longer-term vision of a natural wood playground and timber-frame pavilion for the park in the works.

In the coming months, the immediate plan is to install the engraved bricks received to date in the walkway separating the pickleball court from



the future park/pavilion. So order your bricks online at www.seabeckcc.org or at https://polarengraving. com/seabeckcc to leave your footprint in stone. - Rick Rickert, SCC Treasurer
